Questions

1. A company has added several user-defined fields (UDFs) to the business partner master data. Some users do NOT notice the fields in the side window.

What can the super user do to help these users?

Please choose the correct answer.

a)	<input type="radio"/>	Select the option to view user-defined fields for each user.
b)	<input type="radio"/>	Change the user authorization to full authorization for business partners.
c)	<input type="radio"/>	Create a UI Configuration Template and move the fields to the main window.

2. The accountant notices that there are open invoices in the system, although a payment was received.
